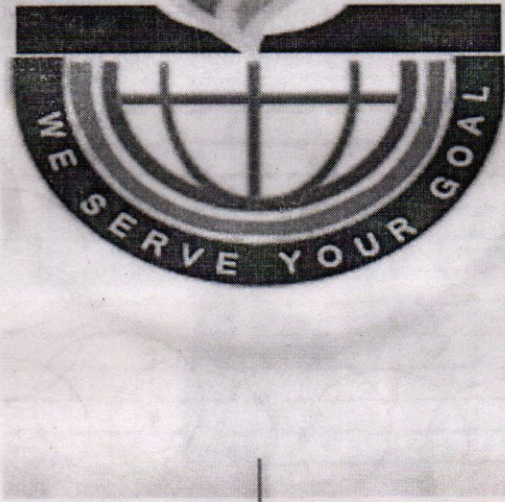

And whereas if any vacancy made in Board of trustees these vacancy can be fulfilled by Co-option.

Whereas the Settler is desirous of establishing a trust for public charitable objects.

And whereas the trustees have, at the request of the settler, agreed to act as the first trustees of these presents as testified their being parties to and executing these presents.

And whereas it is necessary to declare the aims and objects of the public Charitable Public Trust, being constituted under these presents.

Now this indenture witnesseth as follows: -

1. That, in order to effectuate his aforesaid desire, the settler has set apart and handed over to the trustees, a sum of Rs. 51,000 Fifty one Thousand (hereinafter called the "Trust Fund" which expression shall include cash and any other property of investments of any kind whatsoever into which the same or any part thereof might be converted, invested or varied from time to time which may be acquired by the trustees or may come to their hands by virtue of these presents or by operation of law or otherwise howsoever in relation to these presents), and the trustees shall hold and stand possessed of the same upon the trust subject to the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations hereinafter contained.

That the name of the trust shall be **GEETANJALI EDUCATIONAL & CHARITABLE TRUST** its Registered office will be situated at **UNION TOLA, JAYNAGAR, WARD NO. 03, DIST. - MADHUBANI, PIN - 847226, BIHAR [INDIA]** and/or at such other place or places as the trustees may decide from time to time.

2. That the objects for which this trust is established are:

[A.] To set motion and play a proactive role in giving direction for a quiet social movement/revolution for socio-economical, educational, cultural, scientific, technical, financial, ethical prosperity and take spearheaded initiative to spread the gain or prosperity in the benefit of throughout masses of world of living creature.

[B.] To organise, promote, undertake, sponsor, carry-out, all programmes for the benefit of naturally-challenged person, schedule caste, schedule tribes, people under poverty line, old-aged, widow, and down trodden irrespective of caste, creed, sex and religion such as: -

I. In the field of Human Resource Development: -

a) To establish, develop, maintain schools, colleges, libraries, universities, laboratories, skill development centres, competition, preparation centres, yoga and spiritual centres, sports training centres, vocational training centres, research and other institutions for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge among the public in general.

b) To establish, develop, maintain construst, collaborate, amalgamate, takeover, acquire and run or manage and grant aid in cash or in kind to Hospitals, Medical Schools, Medical Colleges, Nursing Institutions, Dispensaries, Maternity Homes, Child Welfare centers, Deaddiction Centres, Hospice, Alternative Therapeutic Centres and/or such other similar Charitable Institutions for the benefit and use of the general public.

c) To establish, support, collaborate, amalgamate, takeover, acquire and run or manage, grant aid or other financial assistance to Schools, Academies Colleges, Libraries, Reading Rooms, Universities. Laboratories, Physical Education, Research and Technology and other Institutions of the

Medals and other incentives to study, without any distinction as to caste, colour, race, creed or sex.

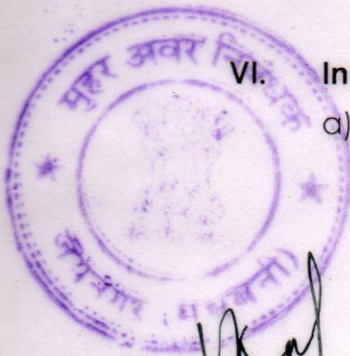

- b) To undertake and run the integrated programme on street children rehabilitation, juvenile justice, adoption resource, agency, social defence, civil defence, old age home/multi service centre, treatment and rehabilitation of addicts, persons with disabilities, coaching and allied assistance, construction of hostel building and other infrastructure for complete rehabilitation centre, vocational training centres, women empowerment, animal welfare, stop prostitution, eradication of poverty.

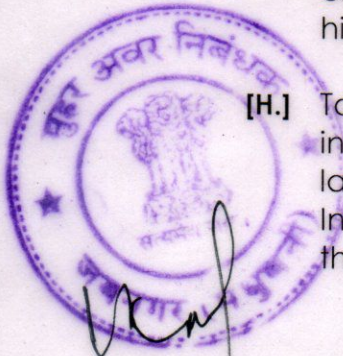

3. All the activities shall be Non Profitable and shall be done on 'No Profit-No Loss' basis.
4. All the incomes, earnings, movable/immovable properties of the trust shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its Aims and Objects only as set forth in the deed of the trust and no profit thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits or in any manner whatsoever to the present or the past member of the trust or to any person claiming through any one or more of the present or the past members. No members of the trust shall have any personal claim on any movable or immovable properties of the trust or make any profits, whatsoever, by virtue of his membership.
5. That the Trust Fund may be augmented by the income from the initial fund and also by donations and other contribution from time to time.
6. That the Trust Fund shall not be applied for any purpose other than those specified in Para 3 herein above unless the other objects added to the trust objectives.
7. That the Trustees shall always maintain proper accounts of the Trust, which shall be kept at the office of the trust.
8. Subject to the Provisions of Income Tax Act. 1961 as amended from time to time, the Trustees will keep the Trust Fund or such portion thereof, as they may, in their absolute discretion, think fit and proper, without being answerable or accountable to the beneficiaries or any other party for any loss invested in such shares, stock, securities and debentures of acquisition or construction of any immovable property including buildings and/or in the purchase and acquisition or mortgage by way of fresh charge on any immovable property in India, of free-hold

or lease-hold tenure, and may deposit the amounts with any scheduled Bank, Company or Private firm or Individual on such terms and conditions as they think fit, In the matter of investment of Trust funds, the provisions of section 20 of the Indian Trust Act shall apply; in the event of Trustees purchasing any immovable property or properties or advancing moneys or mortgage, they shall be entitled to accept such title or evidence of title as they shall think fit in their absolute and uncontrolled discretion. The Trustees shall have power, if any deed it in their absolute discretion to sell the Trust Fund or any part thereof and any such immovable property purchased by them under the power aforesaid and any other shares, securities, etc. and stand possessed of the money to arise from such sale upon after paying there out the expenses pertaining to such sale upon the Trusts and with the subject to powers and provision including all the posers contained by and under these presents declared and contained concerning the Trust Fund which or the proceeds thereof, shall have laid out in purchase of property or properties as have laid out in purchase of property or properties as aforesaid or such of them as shall be then subsisting and capable of taking effect.

- (xi) To give aid by way of donations out of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or otherwise, to different charitable institutions, societies, organisations or Trusts in India which may have been established or which may hereinafter be established for the like charitable purposes mentioned in these presents or any of them to enable such institution, societies, organisation or Trustees to start maintain, or carry out such charitable objects.
- (xii) To settle all accounts and to compromise, abandon, or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or disputes, claim, demand or things, as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
- (xiii) To borrow money either on the security of any property comprised in the Trust Fund or otherwise for all or any of the purposes of these presents, and it shall be lawful for the Trustee to make such borrowings on payment of such interest and otherwise on such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.
- (xiv) To apply to the Government, public bodies, urban, local municipal, district and other bodies, corporation, companies, or persons for and to accept grant of money and of aid, donations, gifts, subscriptions, affiliation and other assistance with a view to promote the objects of the Trust and to discuss and negotiate with the Government Departments, public and other bodies corporations, companies or persons, scheme and other work and matters within the objects of the Trust and to put to any proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.
- (xv) To take over or amalgamate with any other Charitable Public Trust, Trust, association, or institution with similar objects.

(xvi) To take over, acquire, manage, control or aid any existing institution or institutions having objects either wholly or in part similar to the objects of this Trust and on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.

(xvii) To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagement of any or more of the trusts, societies, institutions or associations with which this Trust is authorised to amalgamate.

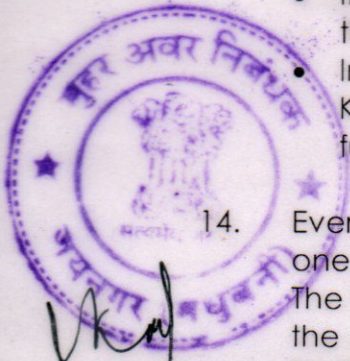
10. The Trustees shall be accountable only for such money, and funds, which will actually come into their hands.

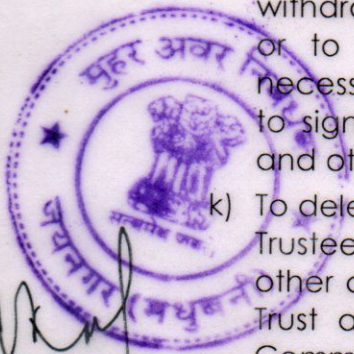

- j) To institute, conduct, defend, compound, withdraw, compromise, adjust, refer to arbitration or to do such things as are incidental and necessary, concerning the affairs of the Trust and to sign and verify vakalats, pleadings, affidavits and other powers'
- k) To delegate all or any of the powers vested in the Trustees to any body' to frame rules, bylaws and other codes for the conduct of the affairs of the Trust and its transactions and establishing any Committee;

- m) To establish as many adhoc committees for any purpose.

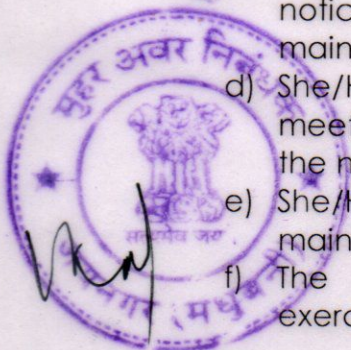
22. POWER & FUNCTION OF THE OFFICE BEARER

President:

- a) The President is responsible for ensuring that the Trust pursues its Objects and for maintaining the dignity of the Trust organization and shall use his/her influence to promote the activities of the Trust.
- b) The President shall be the executive authority of the Trust.
- c) He/she shall preside over all meetings of the Board of Trustees, etc.

SECRETARY:

- a) The Secretary shall execute, enforce and carry out the directives of the President and resolutions and decisions of the Board of Trustees.
- d) The Secretary is authorized to sign all documents, including bank documents, acknowledgements for the contributions received, and agreements with individuals, Government Institutions and other organizations, on behalf of the Board of Trustees.
- b) The Secretary is empowered to remove any Trustee from the Trust and its offices, if he/she finds that his/her activities are not congenial to the activities of the Trust.
- c) She/He shall call meetings of the Trust, circulate notices and agenda notes for meetings and maintain the 'minutes book'.
- d) She/He shall record the proceedings of all meetings and shall put them up for approval in the next meeting.
- e) She/He shall be responsible for updating and maintaining the list of members of the Trust.
- f) The Secretary, in case of emergency, may exercise all the powers and perform all the

functions required to be exercised and performed under these rules, the Board of Trustee Provided that all such actions taken by the Secretary shall be placed before the Board of Trustee in the next meeting immediately following the exercise of such powers and functions by the Secretary.

- g) She/He shall be custodian of all the records of the trust.
- h) The Secretary may inspect any institutions belonging to the Trust to see its proper functioning and working. The Secretary may apply his emergency power for the betterment of such institution, if he thinks fit subjects to post facto approval by the Board of Trustee within three months.
- i) The Secretary shall have the rights to all meetings of the Board of Trustee, and decide the venue, date and time.
- j) The Secretary shall operate Bank Account Jointly with the Treasurer or with other Board of Trustees.
- k) The Secretary shall have power to spend any amount as per as the requirement of the trust.

TREASURER

- a) The Treasurer will act under the direction of the Committee.
- b) Any amount exceeding 5,000/- (Five Thousand) which is not required for immediate use shall be paid into such bank or banks as may be approved or by the committee. The Treasurer shall ordinarily receive all payments and disburse the amount passed by the Settler-cum-Managing

25. SURPLUS INCOME

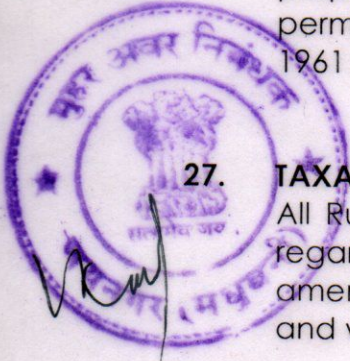
